Acceptance of OOTF Policies for Operating, Membership and Code of Ethics

I understand that the Ohio Olmstead Task Force's (OOTF) Operating Policies, Membership Policy, and Code of Ethics describe procedures, how a person becomes a member of OOTF, the reasons for being taken off the membership list, and the ways we expect members to treat each other. These documents will be used as a guide during my membership in OOTF. If I have any questions that are not answered in these documents, I will ask the OOTF Chair or members of the OOTF Steering Committee for further explanation.

I know and accept that there may be changes to the policies and that the OOTF may add new policies, as well as replace, change, or cancel current policies. I know that any changes only can be approved by a majority vote of OOTF in an announced meeting.

I have read OOTF's Operating Policies, Membership Policy, and Code of Ethics and I know that it is my duty to follow the policies in these documents and any changes made to them. While OOTF membership is open to any number of active members and interested parties representing a variety of people, including people with disabilities, family members, members of disability organizations, organizations that work with people with disabilities, people interested in disability issues and advocates, OOTF keeps the right to end an individual or organizational membership if the member is not fulfilling the policies or the Code of Ethics.
